This letter is regarding [REDACTED] who has been officially accepted to the University of South Florida's Veteran to Bachelor of Science in Nursing program for Fall 2017 as a full-time student. We have been asked to provide the following:

1. Any conditions on acceptance: none
2. Expected start date: August 2017
3. Expected graduation date: December 2018
4. Time frame: The student can complete the program in 24 months or less.
5. Accreditation: The University of South Florida's College of Nursing is accredited by the Commission of Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE), One DuPont Circle, NW Suite 530, Washington, DC 20036, (202)887-6791. The College of Nursing's last CCNE accreditation date was 2010; the College of Nursing's CCNE accreditation is good through 2020.
6. The University of South Florida's College of Nursing NCLEX pass rate for 2016 was 94.31%
7. Projected University Tuition and Fees for the Program per semester (four semesters required):
 - a. Semester 1 (13 credits @ \$211.19 per credit hour): \$2,745.47
 - b. Semester 2 (16 credits @ \$211.19 per credit hour): \$3,379.04
 - c. Semester 3 (14 credits @ \$211.19 per credit hour): \$2,956.66
 - d. Semester 4 (13 credits @ \$211.19 per credit hour): \$2,745.47

Please note the College of Nursing has a mandatory, in-person orientation on Friday, July 21, 2017. Failure to attend the mandatory College of Nursing orientation will result in a forfeiture of your seat in the program.

The projected cost is for in-state tuition rates. The tuition rates listed are for estimation purposes only and are subject to change. The above calculations are for Nursing courses only. If a student needs other University requirements to complete his/her degree, there will be additional tuition and fees for those courses.
