3. Personnel listed above must meet all requirements IAW AR 601-20, AR 40-501, AR 670-1, AR 600-9, and MILPER message 24-232 before attending IPAP. If an applicant does not meet the requirements listed above, they must notify the IPAP manager immediately. Failure to comply with requirements may result in termination from selection into the program. See IPAP website for detailed requirements. <https://recruiting.army.mil/armypa/>.

4. IPAP class dates:

- a. IPAP class 26-1 – Report 30 November 2025 with projected graduation of 9 June 2028.
- b. IPAP class 26-2 – Report 12 April 2026 with projected graduation of 6 October 2028.
- c. IPAP class 26-3 – Report 9 August 2026 with projected graduation of 2 February 2029.

5. All IPAP enlisted soldiers are required to meet the service remaining requirement of 36 months beyond the projected graduation when they start IPAP. A copy of the soldier's reenlistment contract must be provided to the IPAP manager prior to receiving orders to Fort Sam Houston, Texas.

6. All IPAP selects must have a current Basic Life Support (BLS) certification that will last the duration of phase I (16 months) per IPAP guidelines.

7. All 68W must hold and maintain a current National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians basic certifications (NREMT-B) while in the IPAP.

8. Orders – Soldiers attending IPAP will be placed in ATRRS 60-90 days prior to the start of IPAP. IPPS-A orders notification along with this MILPER message will serve as

authorization for the installation PSB to publish orders. Soldiers should not contact their career manager nor the IPAP manager to request orders.

9. Personnel/Financial – If there have been any changes to your personnel status, notify the IPAP manager immediately. (UCMJ, PCS, ADSO, Deployment, AFT failure, flags, surgery, etc.).

10. IPAP selects must maintain command and branch support for attending IPAP in the form of an approved release via Personnel Action Request (PAR) in IPPS-A within 90 days of this MILPER publication and/or official notification of selection. Command and branch support for attendance must be maintained until such time as they report to IPAP (non-waiverable administrative requirement). Failure to maintain command and branch support may result in removal from the selection list and from the OML.

11. All selects are encouraged to repeat a medical terminology course either by correspondence, online class, or in the classroom.

12. All selects will be contacted by the University of Nebraska Medical Center after arrival to IPAP.

13. Once an applicant receives a course welcome letter, unit stabilizations and reenlistment assignments will be waived by Retention and Reclassification Branch.

14. All selects receiving special pays to include flight pay must coordinate with Soldier Programs and Services Division for a determination on special pay continuation prior to their report date to IPAP.
